

FPYC Flag Football 2024 FAQ's



1. How can I register? Go to <u>www.fpycsports.com</u> click registration. Online registration will remain open through March 31st. Registrations after this time will go on a wait list.

2. What is the cost for registration?

- 3. Do you offer scholarships? Yes, we have a limited number of reduced fee scholarships available. They are issued first come first served. Cost is \$75.00.
- 4. Do I need a DMV Child ID or Birth Certificate for proof of age to play? No. Players are not required to provide an ID or birth certificate. However, parents will be asked to verify their child's age upon request.
- 5. Can girls play? Yes. All teams are co-ed.
- 6. What are the age groups for the teams? Age groups are divided as follows:

- 7. What is the time commitment? In season, there is only one (1-hour) practice and one (1-hour) game per week, both on the same day, same location.
- **8. When are practices and games?** Practices and games are scheduled to take place on Sunday afternoons. However, at the coach's discretion, teams will be allowed preseason practices in March. Note: Weekday games could be scheduled as make up for rain outs.
- **9. Where will games be played?** Games will be played at Stafford Drive Park and Fairfax High School.
- 10. My child plays another sport (baseball, soccer, lacrosse), will the flag football schedule conflict with other sports? We are monitoring other sports to reduce the chance of this happening. By focusing on Sunday afternoons, we think we can avoid most conflicts.

11. When does the season begin? Assessments are March 10th at **Fairfax High School**. The season will run from March 10th to June 9th. No games or practices on Sunday mornings, Spring Break Weekend, Easter Sunday, Mother's Day, and Memorial Day.

- **12. What are assessments?** Assessments evaluate a player's ability. How they grade will allow coaches to draft teams as equally as possible. Assessments are conducted combine style consisting of agility, running, catching, and throwing drills.
- **13. My child cannot attend assessments. What should I do?** Any player who cannot attend assessments will be placed into a blind draft and will be selected to a team using a lottery drawing method.
- 14. How are teams formed? Teams are age based and will be formed using a draft process after assessments.
- **15.** Can my child be placed on a team for purposes of carpool, friend request, etc? We cannot guarantee this. We will inform coaches of all teaming requests during the draft process. Players are encouraged to sign up if they are interested in playing flag with the understanding, they will be able to interact frequently with their friends even if they aren't on the same team. In addition, we strive to form teams as equal as possible.
